	Welcome and Introductions by the Chair
	Attendance: PCs Graham White, Paul Lane, Jocasta Bullock, Ross Sharpe, District Councillor Julia Judd. Three members of public
3.	There were no apologies to be recorded.
4.	There were no Declarations of Interest for matters on the agenda
5.	Minutes of the Parish Council Annual Meeting held on 17 th June 2024 were approved.
6.	Report by Cllr Judd:
	Cllr Judd apologized for being unable to attend the last meeting. The District Council is working to address issues arising from changes to refuse collection arrangements. So far Daglingworth had been affected by food waste collections being late. She reminded the meeting that any contentious planning matters should be reported to her as soon as possible to ensure she could make comments as necessary. Works to the Missing Link had caused some disruption to traffic. Cllr Judd was taking a party of PCs to Javelin Park incinerator in November. Jocasta Bullock expressed interest Ross Sharpe would be a reserve candidate.
7.	Millenium Green bridge: the Chair raised this urgent item as maintenance is necessary. A member of the public who originally built the bridge when a Parish Councillor proposed that further steel supports should be inserted to support wooden structure along with anti slip tiles. Cost estimated £324 plus vat. The Council thanked him for his help and agreed to meet the cost as finalised including possible hire of generator for welding.
8.	Daglingworth Stream above Grove Hill: The Duchy is awaiting funding from Farming on Protected Landscape which would allow works to start in the Autumn. Awaiting news from Joe Hasley.
9.	Planning Matters:
	Bridge Cottage: after successful lobbying from neighbours, CDC has requested further information from the applicant.
	Manor Farm building: after some discussion the PC agreed to revert to CDC seeking further consideration and CIIr Judd will make further representations at District level.

10.	Highways and Drainage Matters:
	High Bank cutting now part of Nic's Mowing contract. GCC liaising with CDC over surface water drainage at School Lane and Lower End. Residents are now also seeking work to slow run off from Dowers Hill. Chair recollected a catchment at Itlay in the form of silt trap. Cllr Bullock to locate and send take three words to Chair for onward transmission to GCC to be included when silt trap in Overley Hill is cleared.
